

Skylark Galleries support ECHO at Summer Art Exhibition

We are delighted to have been supported by Skylark Galleries London who donated 5% of their beautiful summer exhibition to ECHO, raising over £525.

The exhibition is a collection of uplifting and vibrant works from 22 artists. Works available included original paintings and drawings, artist's hand-pulled prints — such as linocuts and screenprints, as well as mixed media, collage, ceramic and sculptural artworks.

The exhibition ran for 2 weeks and was hosted at the Oxo Tower Wharf on the main ground floor gallery area. In addition, the Skylark Collective has two permanent galleries nearby: one on the first floor of the Oxo Tower above the gallery@oxo, and the other in Gabriel's Wharf.

The exhibition launched with a special invite-only evening and drew in hundreds of people every day, on the iconic London South Bank.
