Car parking

Parking for patients and visitors is very limited, and there is often a queue. The car park is 'pay on foot' so please have the correct change. You can also pay by credit or debit card. Pay and get your exit ticket before returning to your car.

Parking charges:

- £3.20 per hour
- disabled patients are given free parking in the main car park upon production of their blue badge registered in their name along with an appointment card
- parking charges apply 24 hours a day.

Please use public transport whenever possible.

Evelina London and St Thomas' Hospital are located in the congestion charging zone.

Public Transport

Tube

The nearest tube stations are:

- Westminster District, Circle and Jubilee lines (10 minutes' walk)
- Waterloo Bakerloo, Jubilee and Northern lines (15 minutes' walk)

Lambeth North - Bakerloo line (10 minutes' walk)

Train

The nearest Train stations are:

Waterloo, Waterloo East, and are a 10-15 minutes' walk away.

Victoria and Charing Cross are 20-30 minutes' walk away.

Bus



Allow 15-20 minutes to get from the bus stop to where you need to be in the hospital. The following bus routes serve St Thomas' Hospital/Evelina London

- 12, 53, 148, 159, 211, 453, C10 stop at Westminster Bridge Road
- 77, 507, N44 stop at Lambeth Palace Road
- 3, 344, C10, N3 stop at Lambeth Road (15 minutes walk)
- 76, 341, 381, RV1 stop at York Road
- N44, N155, N159, N381 night buses stop at Westminster Bridge Road
- N3 night bus stops at Lambeth Road

Facilities

Play areas

There are play areas in the wards with games, books, computers, TV and music centres.

In the outpatients department on the ground floor there are lots of toys and games and a large helter skelter slide.

Pharmacy

The Evelina London pharmacy is on the ground floor of Evelina London. open Monday-Friday, 10am-5.30pm.

The pharmacy is closed on Saturdays, although a pharmacy service is available on the wards. There is no pharmacy service on Sundays.

There's also a Sainsbury's pharmacy in <u>St Thomas' Hospital</u> where families can buy toiletries and overthe-counter medicines.

There is also wide range of shops and services available right next door in St Thomas' Hospital.

Cafés

There is an AMT café on the ground floor of Evelina London, towards the back of the hospital and in the third floor atrium, both serve drinks and food.



Opening hours:

- Monday-Friday, 6.30am-6.30pm
- Saturday 8am-3.45pm
- Sunday 8.30am-3.45pm.

There is also an AMT coffee shop at St Thomas' Hospital, open 24 hours, seven days a week.

There are also vending machines located across the hospital.

MediCinema

<u>MediCinema</u> is a state-of-the art cinema for patients, their family and carers to enjoy, based at St Thomas' Hospital in the Prideaux Lecture Theatre. The facilities screen the latest box-office releases – and they're free.

Screenings for Evelina London are on Wednesdays at 6pm.

Tickets are usually distributed on the wards by a MediCinema manager or volunteer - if you're not sure how to get a ticket, talk to your nurse.

All tickets need to be signed off by a nurse to make sure your child is well enough to attend a screening. If your child is an outpatient, you'll need to provide proof that they're being treated at Evelina, such as an appointment letter.
